BYE, BLUE FLY!

This is a game for 2-4 players (or teams). Before playing the game revise or pre-teach the Saying Goodbye rhyme by using question cards. Use them as flashcards.

Shuffle playing and wild cards. Make your own game course by placing the cards face up (answer side down) on the floor (or table) like this:



Students roll the dice and land on a card.

If it is a wild card, he or she follows the instruction (e.g. Miss a turn or sing an English song).

If it is a question card, he or she has to say a rhyme for the animal: e.g.

Goodbye, Dragonfly! See you later, Alligator! (check by flipping the card).

Each correct answer gains one point. The student with the most points wins the game.

Preparation


Print out playing and wild cards. If you want, you can stick the printout onto the heavy paper.
